Walking:

Heath Training and Development Centre is approximately 20 minutes walk from Halifax town centre and a 20-25 minute walk from the Railway Station.

Bus:

Journey time from Halifax is approximately 10 minutes. A service runs every 10 minutes. From the bus stop take a short walk along Heath Road then onto Free School Lane. Cycle :

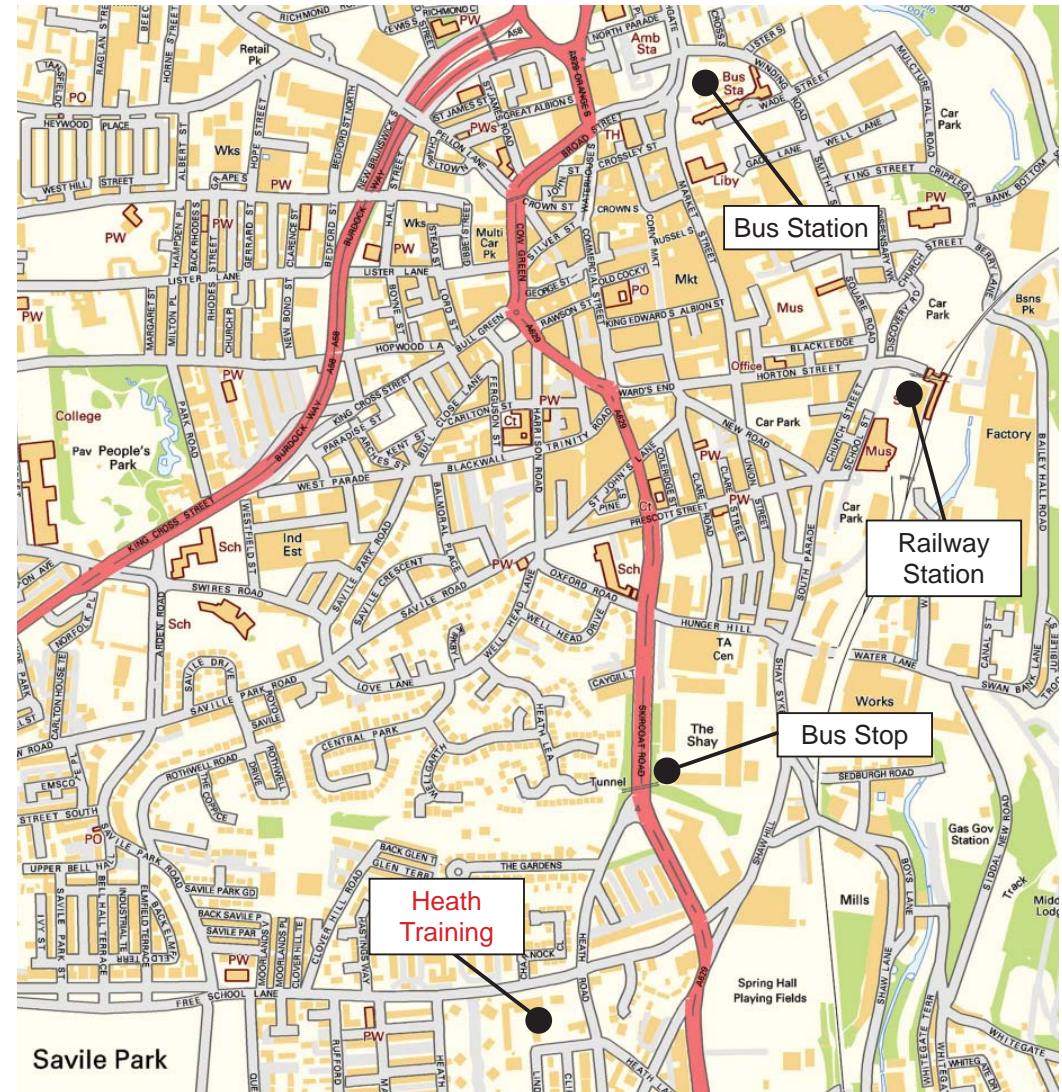
There are no cycle racks, but cycles can be securely stored inside the buildings on arrival.
